

Installing the batteries

This unit is powered by 2 main CR2032 batteries and the databank memory is powered by 1 CR2032 battery. The unit begins to dim when the battery power is low. When this happens, replace the 2 main batteries immediately. To install or replace the main batteries do the following.



Replacing the Main Batteries

- 1. Turn the unit off.
- 2. Turn the unit over.
- Slide the tab of the battery compartment lock to the unlock position.
- Lift the battery cover up and off.
- Remove the old batteries and insert the new batteries with the positive (+) sides facing up.
- 6. Replace the cover.
- 7. Return the tab to the lock position.

Installing the batteries

Replacing the Databank Memory Battery

You need not replace the databank memory battery unless you continued to operate the unit when the main batteries power was low. In such a case, replace the main batteries. This is to safeguard any data in your databank.

- 1. Turn the unit off.
- 2. Turn the unit over.
- With a Phillips screwdriver, remove the screw to the databank memory battery cover and remove the cover.
- Remove the old battery and insert the new battery with the positive (+) side facing up.
- 5. Replace the cover and screw it back on.

Resetting the Unit

The reset button is recessed in a pin-sized hole on the front of your unit on the left side. To reset your unit, use a paper clip and gently press the reset button. Do NOT apply excessive pressure as this will damage the unit. **Note**: Once you reset the unit, all data in the databank will be lost. Please keep separate written records of all your data.

Getting Started

You have to choose a message language when you first turn your unit on. The message language is the language of screen messages and menu items. Press the number below the language you want to select it as your message language.

- ◆ Changing the Message Language
 You can change the message language at any
 time. Press → and then press the number for
 the language you want.
- ◆ Turning the Keytone Off and On
 The keytone is the beep that sounds whenever a key is pressed. When the keytone is on, an icon (♣) appears on the screen. To turn the keytone on, press S(♣). Press S again to turn the keytone off.
- Changing Screen Contrast

You can change the screen contrast to suit your viewing needs. To do this, press ⊚ and then use ▲ and ▼ to make the screen darker or lighter.

♦ Setting the Alarm

You can set the alarm in the 24-hour format. Press then press A(ALARM). Use or to cycle through the ON/OFF, hour and minute fields. Use ★ or ▼ to make your changes. Press Nent when done.

Key Guide

The number keys select the language printed above them at the Set Message Language screen.

Function Keys

Goes to the Euro converter.

Goes to the Translator.

Goes to the Databank.

Goes to the Calculator

ABÇ Starts spell correction.

Turns the unit on and off. Displays clock

Returns to the Entry screen in the Translator. Clears the calculator.

Deletes an entry in the main databank mode. Deletes a character to the right in the databank edit mode.

(\$) Goes to the Currency Converter.

Goes to the Set Message Language screen.

Starts the Edit mode.

SPACE Types a space.

Key Guide

Shows synonyms for the source word in the Translator.

Shows synonyms for the target word in the Translator.

Enters a selection or stores a record.

Types an accent.

Direction Keys

 Deletes a character to the left or moves the cursor to the left.

Moves the cursor to the right.

Moves up through the entries found in the Translator. In the clock edit mode, increases the numbers.

Moves down through the entries found in the Translator. In the clock edit mode, decreases the numbers.

Moves up through all the Translator entries.

Moves down through all the Translator entries.

Using the Clocks

Each time you turn the unit on, the first screen you see is Local time. You can set the local city, the current time and the date.

Setting Local Time

1. Press 🖜.

The flashing L indicates Local time.

2. Press 🔗.

The city name flashes.

You may also type the first letter of the city you want. You see the first city starting with that letter. Use ▼ to find your city. If you don't find your city, choose one in the same time zone.

- 4. Press to go to the next field.

Use ▶ to cycle through the time and date fields. Use ▼ and ▲ to make your changes. The day changes automatically.

6. Press (ENTER) when done.

Changing Formats

Once you set the local time you can view it in several formats.

1. Press 🐠.

Using the Clocks

2.	Press (12/24) to toggle between the 12-	
	hour and 24-hour format.	

3. Press (DST) to see Daylight Savings Time.

Press (x) (DST) again to return to Standard time.

4. Press ()(DATE) to see the date.

To toggle between the mm-dd-yy and dd-mmvy displays, press (MD/DM).

Press (/)(DATE) to return to the City/Time screen.

The settings are retained until you change them.

You can translate a word from a source (FROM) language to a target (TO) language. You can also view the translations of hundreds of useful phrases. You can change both the source and the target languages.

Translating Words

- 1. Press III.
- 2. Use ▶ or ◀ to find the source language you want.

You can also press the number for the language you want.

- 3. Press ▼.
- Use ▶ or ◀ to find the target language you want.
- 5. Press ENTER to see the Word/Categories screen.
- **6. Press** again to select *Word*. You see a blank Word entry screen.
- 7. Type the word you want to translate.

To type an accent, type the letter first then press (an) repeatedly until you find the accent you want.

To delete a character to the left of the cursor, press \blacktriangleleft .

To clear all the typing, press (LEAR).

If you want to see the word in another target language, press the number of the other language. Note: Your target language is now set until you change it again.

8. Press (ENTER).

The number of translations found is displayed on the screen if your word is in this translator. Otherwise, you go to the next closest word in the word list

- Press ✓ or ▲ to view the translations.
 Asterisks indicate the end of the list.
- Press ↓ or ↑ to view other words in the word list.

You may start typing a new word to look up at any time.

◆ Correcting Misspelling

If you are unsure of how a word is spelled, type the word as you think it is spelled and press ABC. A list of possible corrections appears. Press to go down the list. Press when you find the word you want.

Viewing Phrase Translations

- 1. Press III.
- Select the source and target languages following the steps in "Translating Words" and press [NTER].
- Press or to scroll through the 13 categories and press to select the one you want.
- Press or to scroll through the source language phrases in the category you selected.
- 6. Press NIRE to see the translation of the one you want.

- 7. Press (INTER) to return to the phrases in the source language.
- 8. Press (CLEAR) to return to the Categories list.

◆ Understanding More, Alt and arrows You may see More, Alt or arrows at different times on the screen. Here's what they mean.

Alt Press (ALT) to view synonyms of the source word.

More Press MORE to view synonyms of the target word.

Press to scroll up the list of word entries found, or list of categories.

 Press to scroll down the list of word entries found, or list of categories.

Press to scroll right.

Press to scroll left.

Press to see the next word or phrase entry in the translator.

◆ Press ★ to see the previous word or phrase entry in the translator.

Using the Databank

Use your databank to store names, phone numbers or memos. Press the number key of the language you want as your input language.

Entering a Record

- 1. Press 🕻 🗏.
- 2. Type a name.

Press ◀ to delete a character to the left of the cursor.

Press (CLEAR) to delete all the typed letters.

- 3. Press ENTER to go to the next field.
- 4. Type a phone number or memo.
- **5. Press** To store your data. The names are stored in alphabetical order.

Viewing Records

- 1. Press 🕻 🗏.
- 2. Press 👃.

You see the first name on the alphabetically ordered list.

Using the Databank

You can also type the first letter of a name to go to the first name starting with that letter or you can type the full name.

4. Press ENTER to view the Phone/Memo data.

Editing a Record

You can edit each field in a record individually.

1. Press 📞 🗏.

flashes.

- Find the field you want to edit following the steps in "Viewing Records".
- 3. Press .

 The cursor is under the first character and it
- Use to move the cursor to the letter or number you want to change and type the new letter or number.

The old letter moves to the right. Press (LEAR) to delete it.

5. Press ENTER to store the edited information.

Using the Databank

Deleting Records

To delete a single record, do the following:

- 1. Press 🕻 📗
- Find the name of the record you want to delete following the steps in "Viewing Records."
- 3. Press (CLEAR).

You see the message Delete Y/N?

4. Press Y to delete the record.

Press **N** to cancel the deletion.

The unit returns to the databank entry screen.

To delete the entire databank, do the following:

- 1. Press 🕻 🗐.
- 2. Press (CLEAR).

You see the message Delete All Y/N?

3. Press Y to delete all the records.

Press N to cancel the deletion.

The unit returns to the databank entry screen.

Using the Calculator

Use the Calculator to do standard arithmetic calculations, memory calculations and percent calculations.

Note: The calculator function keys are autoshifted in the Calculator.

- 1. Press (* ‡).
- 2. Type a number.

You can type up to 10 digits. To type a decimal, press $(\ ^{\mathsf{C}}_{\mathsf{K}})(_{\bullet}).$

- Press a calculator function key and type another number.
- 4. Press (ENTER) to perform the calculation.

Using the Converters

Using the Metric Converter

The following metric conversions are built-in:

The conversion keys are autoshifted in the Calculator, Currency Converter and Euro Converter. To perform a metric conversion, do the following:

- 1. Press (x̄+, ('\$)) or €.
- Press the key for the conversion you wish to perform.
- 3. Type the number you wish to convert.
- 4. Press ENTER to convert it.

To reverse the direction of the conversion, press **M**(INV).

Using the Currency Converters

Your organizer comes with a Currency Converter in which you can set the rates.

- 1. Press (%)
- 2. Press 🔗.

The conversion rate flashes.

Using the Converters

3. Enter a conversion rate.

Note: The rate you enter must equal 1 unit of the HOME currency.

You can change HOME and OTHER to the currency abbreviations you want. Press ▼ to change HOME to the abbreviation of your choice. You can enter a maximum of 5 letters. Press ▼ to change OTHER to the abbreviation of your choice. Note: You can press to erase all the letters first and then type your own letters.

4. Press ENTER).

The currencies and rate are now set until you change them.

- Enter the amount you want to convert and press (ENTER).
- To reverse the direction of conversion, press M(INV).

Using the Euro Converter

Press € for the Euro Converter. The built-in rates are those adopted by the Council of the European Union for the 11 participating countries. Press ♣ or ♠ to scroll through the list and find the desired currency. Type in the amount to convert. To reverse the direction of the conversion, press M(INV).

Setting the Password

To Set a Password

- 1. Press 🐠.
 - Look for the flashing **L** to make sure you are in the Local Time mode.
- 2. Press L(LOCK).
- 3. Enter a password using a maximum of six characters.

Warning: Keep a copy of your password in a safe place. If you forget your password, you have to reset the unit before you can use the databank and all previously stored information is lost.

- 4. Press ENTER.
 - You are prompted to enter your password again to confirm it.
- Re-enter your password, and press ENTER.
 Your password is locked until you change it.
 - Changing or Deleting a Password

Follow Steps 1 and 2 above. Type your password and press [NIER]. Your password is deleted. Follow the steps above to set a new password.
